

# Troop 650 Iron Man Designation and Requirements

Troop 650 has endeavored to create a special Iron Man designation for all interested Scouts of Troop 650. The requirements for the designation will be successfully completing 8 of 14 from the following merit badges:

**A total of any *eight* merit badges completed from the following list of *fourteen***

**Hi-lited merit badges** indicate ones that can be earned at Summer Camp.

## Considerations

Adult leadership recognizes that the some merit badges will require some outside activity separate from the normal troop activities. It is required that Scouts observe the buddy system when working on a merit badge outside troop campouts, summer camps, or troop meetings.

## Time Limit

Scouts would have until their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday to complete the merit badges and become an Iron Man

## Recognition

Troop 650 will design and distribute a patch to each scout that completes the Iron Man requirements; in addition, any scout that achieves the Iron Man will be recognized as having done so at the subsequent Court of Honor.
